

## **REGISTRATION PROCESS**

### **EPIPHANY STUDENTS**

Sacramental Preparation is a SEPARATE registration and formation process concurrent with grade level Faith Formation. If you plan to prepare for First Reconciliation and First Eucharist you must fill out TWO SEPARATE registration forms (one for Faith Formation and one for Sacrament Preparation.)

- ❑ Complete the Faith Formation Registration Form **and** attach or enclose payment.
- ❑ Complete Sacrament Preparation Registration Form **and** attach a copy of your student's Baptism certificate **and** book fee (see Sacrament Preparation Registration form for fee information). Registration is not complete without a copy of your child's Baptism Certificate. This needs to be turned in even if your student was baptized at Epiphany. If you do not have a copy of the Baptism Certificate, please contact the church of Baptism for assistance in obtaining a copy.
- ❑ Turn in all requested documents to Faith Formation Office as soon as possible.

### **CATHOLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS:**

Catholic School students prepare to celebrate sacraments through their home parish. Complete the Sacrament Preparation Registration Form and attach a copy of your student's Baptism certificate, book fee (see Sacrament Preparation Registration form for fee information), and a Letter of Attendance from the catholic school (JPPII sends a letter to Epiphany).

### **FAMILIES TRANSFERRING FROM ANOTHER PARISH**

If your family transferred from another parish to Epiphany this year, you will need to register as parishioners at Epiphany, and then follow the instructions for *Epiphany Students*. You will also need to request a letter of attendance from your previous parish or Catholic School to verify your student's participation in faith formation last year. Please attach this letter to your registration form.
