Our high school students engage their faith in real world application through seminars, guest speakers, and service projects. The knowledge they receive will encourage them to take our Catholic faith and put it into action. Our catechists provide opportunities for our students to reflect and evaluate their relationship with Jesus Christ and His bride, the Catholic Church.

To register:

- You must fill out and submit the included registration form and payment to the Faith Formation Office.
- You will receive a letter in the mail with online enrollment instructions to self-select your student's grade level and day of the week for faith formation. Letters are sent out around July 1st, 2017. The online enrollment system will close September 1st.
- Be sure to double check your class enrollment before classes begin on September 17th.

Faith Formation Sessions

Sundays 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Wednesdays 6:30 p.m. to 7:45 p.m.

Our Sunday students are invited to join us 30 minutes before faith formation in our PAC Great Room for pizza and fellowship. Come be in community with your peers!

Freshmen: Our 9th graders are invited to deepen their understanding of our Catholic faith through specific grade level learning targets, witness talks, guest speakers, presentations, and prayer experiences.

Sophomores: 10th graders will find enrichment through learning about the Sacred Scripture, the Sacraments, Liturgy, Catholic Tradition, and Christian Prayer. *This course is a prerequisite for the Sacrament of Confirmation preparation.*

Juniors: 11th graders will begin a spiritual journey to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. To be confirmed in a faithful community, students will regularly attend Mass and their faith formation class, participate in two retreats, and join in a variety of service projects throughout the year. Seniors interested in receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation must call the office.

Discipleship After Confirmation: Seniors and students who have been confirmed are encouraged to seek personal and spiritual growth. We need students who are interested in sharing their faith with their peers as classroom aids for elementary grades through Confirmation. Our EPIC and ESCAPE Retreats need volunteers to help the participants have an epiphany moment about their relationship with Jesus Christ. We will offer seminars throughout the year to prepare seniors for college. Be sure to check out our website and bulletin for this information.
